



Located off the main lobby of the Y, Child Watch is an onsite, drop-off babysitting service for children ages 6 weeks to 10 years old.

This member service is available to Y members and guests of the Y who purchase a day pass. Parent or guardian must sign their child in and out of the room, and must remain in the building while their child is in Child Watch. Payments are made by cash, check, or credit card and should be paid at the Welcome Center desk after child is picked up.

RATES:

DAILY - PER VISIT RATE:

\$4 per child per visit. Payment is made at the Y Welcome Center desk after child is picked up.

MONTHLY UNLIMITED:

\$25 for 1 child, \$40 for 2 children & \$45 for 3 or more children. Schedule bank draft payments at the Y Welcome Center desk.

PUNCH CARDS:

\$20 for 5 visits & \$50 for 15 visits. Purchase at the Y Welcome Center desk.

CHILD WATCH GUIDELINES:

MAXIMUM 3 HOURS PER CHILD PER DAY FOR AGES 6 WEEKS TO 10 YEARS

- You must remain in the building while your child is in Child Watch.
- Payment is made at the time of service by cash or bank draft. If paying in cash, a payment card will be handed to you upon pick up of your child, and should be paid at the Welcome Center Desk before you leave the building. See Y membership staff for bank draft options.
- Please leave personal belongings at home.
- Please label all of your child's belongings (such as a diaper bag) with their first and last name.
- Please sign your child in and out of Child Watch.

TO MAINTAIN A HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT WE ASK THAT YOU DO NOT BRING YOUR CHILD IF THEY ARE SICK. Should your child become ill while under our care, the parent or guardian will be located and asked to pick up their child from Child Watch.

CHILDREN SHOULD BE KEPT HOME IF THEY HAVE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS:

- > Fever over 100.4. They must be fever free for 24 hours without medication (temperature under 100.4).
- > Rashes or any open sores
- > Yellow or green runny nose

- > Excessive cough or sneezing
- > Diarrhea and/or vomiting
- > Communicable disease
- Child Watch staff may not administer any medication, including diaper rash cream.
- Food is not allowed in Child Watch due to allergies and other health concerns. Children under 2 may have a bottle which must be premixed, only if needed for a meal. Staff will not give any unmarked bottles to a child.
- Please bring children in a clean, dry diaper. If the child is potty training, we ask that they wear a pull-up or diaper. Staff will direct children to the bathroom, but we cannot assist them.
- If your child has an accident, or is in need of clean clothes, diapers or wipes, parents will be located and asked to attend to their child.
- Please dress child appropriately for the weather as we may go outside, weather permitting.

The YMCA reserves the right to ask a parent to remove their child from Child Watch if the child has been crying for more than 10 minutes, is in underwear and has had an accident, or if child is not acting appropriately (hitting, biting, language, etc.). If the inappropriate behavior continues, the parent/guardian may lose child watch privileges.
