# PLEASE EMBRACE THE FAMILY FRIENDLY ENVIRONMENT OF OUR Y.

At the Y, our dress code encourages clothing choices that are respectful, comfortable, and inclusive. Members are asked to wear attire that is appropriate for the activity they are participating in. We embrace diversity and welcome clothing that aligns with individual expression while promoting a safe and respectful environment for all.

#### WEAR PROPER SWIM ATTIRE

Proper swim attire must be worn in the pool and whirlpool. No revealing swim suits, cutoffs, t-shirts, shorts, or other loose clothing. Swimsuits may only be worn in pool areas.

### SHOES ARE REQUIRED EVERYWHERE



Shoes appropriate for the activity must be worn in the facility at all times, except for the pools and locker rooms. Athletic shoes should be worn in the gyms, studios, and Wellness Center during activities.

#### **CLOTHING MUST BE APPROPRIATE FOR THE ACTIVITY**

Activity appropriate attire should be worn in all areas of the Y. Members and guests are requested to wear attire that appropriately covers private areas, fits properly, and is suitable for activities.



- Shirts/tops/tanks need to be worn in all areas, including the gyms.
- Sleeveless tops/tanks may not be strapless.
- Full coverage shorts need to be longer than your glutes.

## 4 NO CRUDE, OFFENSIVE OR PROFANE ATTIRE



Attire must be free of any vulgar or profane wording or graphics.

Tattoos deemed inappropriate must be covered.
