Assists in hands on Aquatic work, and administrative duties to provide a safe environment where members and guests of all ages, cultures, and abilities can enjoy the pool area.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Ensures high quality service and proper implementation of procedures.
- Promotes members connecting with one another and with the Y.
- Ensures building and individuals are secure during shift. Effectively
 manages emergencies and situations with employees, members,
 and guests in accordance with policies. Handles and resolves
 member concerns.
- Assists in keeping staff records up to date and organized. Helps schedule and find instructors for private swimming lessons. Makes sure rosters and forms are completed for swimming lessons.
- The Aquatics Specialist will assist with administering and supervising the aquatics swim programs, and services
- Serve as a Lifeguard and Swim Instructor and will be the go to lead for all Lifeguards and Swim Instructors.
- · Assists with planning and running any aquatics staff meetings.

REOUIREMENTS:

- Experience in administration, staff supervision, pool management, lifeguarding and swimming lessons or previous supervisory and/or management experience preferred.
- Certifications: Basic life support or professional rescuer CPR/AED, first aid, current Red Cross Lifeguard or equivalent preferred
- Must be able to move effectively through all program areas; be able to lift and carry 50 pounds; perform physical functions necessary to program instruction, including but not limited to squatting, bending, kneeling, spotting program participants and demonstrating the use of program apparatuses or program skills.
- Ability to maintain certification-level physical and mental readiness
- Must be able to demonstrate lifeguard skills in accordance with YMCA standards

WAGE SCALE: \$13.00/hour starting; Based on experience. WORK DAYS: Weekdays/nights, weekend hours during program sessions, lifequarding and swim instructing shifts.
