Construction on our facility addition continues to move forward, and next week's work will require several temporary space closures and program adjustments. We appreciate your patience and flexibility as we complete this important phase of the project.

CONSTRUCTION & FACILITY ACCESS | AUGUST 24–28

Fireplace Lounge & Lobby Restroom

- Closed Monday–Friday until 3:00 PM
- Both areas will reopen daily from 3:00 PM–close

Studio 4 | Closing Monday, August 24 & Reopening Tuesday, August 25 at 3 pm

- Studio 4 will be closed all day Monday, August 24 with no access; all classes are canceled
- The studio is expected to reopen at 3:00 pm on Tuesday, August 25; no classes 5am–3pm

These closures allow contractors to safely complete structural work for the addition, including installation of new columns, beams, floor joists and decking, along with associated roof work.
