As construction continues on our Wellness Center expansion, we're preparing for the next exciting phase of the project.

Beginning Monday evening (8/3), construction crews will begin installing temporary construction walls in the lobby near the Welcome Center Desk. Over the next several days, these walls will extend throughout portions of the lobby as we prepare to connect our existing facility to the new Wellness Center addition. **These temporary changes** are an important step in moving construction forward while allowing the YMCA to remain open and operational.

As a result, you'll notice a few temporary changes:

- **Lobby seating** has been relocated to the main hallway and North Atrium. The Fireplace Lounge will remain open and unaffected.
- **Member check-in and membership services** will be temporarily relocated closer to the entrance doors.
- **Traffic flow** throughout the Welcome Center and lobby will be adjusted. Please follow the posted directional signage when entering and exiting the facility.
- **24/7 Access:** There will be no changes to 24/7 member access. Members should continue to scan in upon arrival using their membership card or YMCA app as usual. Members using the facility this evening are asked to use extra caution when entering and exiting the building while construction crews begin installing the temporary construction walls.

Our Welcome Center team will continue to be available during regular business hours to answer questions, assist with check-in, and help direct you through the updated traffic flow.

We understand these temporary adjustments may create some inconvenience, but each phase brings us one step closer to an expanded Wellness Center, a new indoor walking track, additional fitness space, and an even better YMCA experience for our members and community.
