Upcoming Lobby Construction & What to Expect

We're excited to share an update about upcoming improvements to our YMCA! **Beginning February 16**, we'll be starting construction in the lobby area as part of an effort to increase safety and enhance your experience when you walk through our doors.

Please review the information below so you know what to expect during this phase of work.

Lobby Seating Changes – Beginning February 9

To prepare for construction equipment and wall installation, all lobby furniture will be removed and moved to other areas in the facility, starting February 9.

To ensure members still have comfortable seating options, **additional seating will be available** in the:

- North Atrium
- Wellness Center
- Lower Level

Signage will be posted throughout the building to help guide you to these areas and to keep the lobby clear for construction and traffic flow.

Construction Timeline – Phase 1 - Beginning February 16

- Construction walls will be installed in the lobby
- This phase will focus on building a new front desk and office space, and member lobby

Building Access During Construction

The YMCA will continue to use the main entrance throughout construction.

- One set of doors (handicap access, closest to the pool) will be used for entry and exit
- The second set of doors will be reserved for construction crews

Clear signage will be in place to support safe and efficient movement in and out of the building.

Parking Overview

As construction progresses, you may notice some temporary changes to parking availability due to equipment and staging. We encourage members to allow a little extra time when arriving and to follow posted signage and directions from staff.

Thank you for your patience and flexibility as we make these improvements. While there may be temporary adjustments along the way, we're confident these updates will result in a more welcoming and functional space for everyone.
